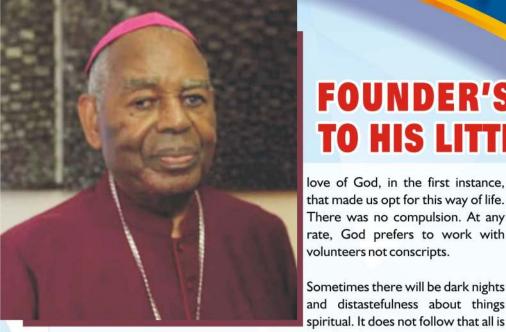

love of God, in the first instance, that made us opt for this way of life. There was no compulsion. At any rate, God prefers to work with volunteers not conscripts.

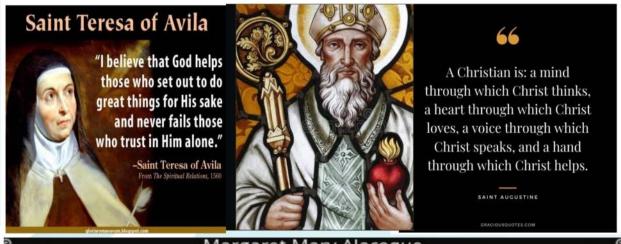

DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART WHY DEVOTION TO THE SACRED HEART?

Extract from "An Easy Understanding of the Sacred Heart Devotion—(A publication of the Sisters of the Sacred Heart)

The devotion to the Sacred Heart is not separate from the devotion to Jesus Himself. The devotion is to the person of Jesus in His deepest reality. It focuses our attention to both the Heart of flesh of Jesus and His abundant and redeeming love for us.

Thus the main reason for the devotion to the Sacred Heart is the immense Love of the son of God, which induced Him to deliver Himself up to death for our sake, and to give Himself totally to us in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar. Therefore Love is the motive and end of the devotion to the Sacred Heart. The devotion is not only the worship and devotion to the physical Heart of Jesus, but to all that the heart symbolizes; devotion to the person of Jesus and to the love of God for humankind.

Another key reason for the devotion to the Sacred Heart is the desire to console our Lord, who has suffered so terribly for our sins – for reparation. This practice is not simply a pious gesture but a beautiful way in which the soul may unite itself to the beloved.

According to St. Pius X11, the object of this devotion; is – "that Christ the Lord – showing His Most Sacred Heart – willed in an



extraordinary and special way, to call the minds of all to the contemplation and veneration of the mystery of God's most merciful love for human race." The devotion to the Sacred

Heart is a call to respond to Jesus' invitation to all humanity in various ways particularly when He beckoned on us in these words; Peter "so, could you not watch with me an hour?" (Matt. 26:40). It is also His request for gratitude and tender love through St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, whom He chose to widely make known the devotion to His Sacred Heart to the whole world.

Therefore, a true love of Jesus Christ, and special respect and veneration for the Blessed Sacrament are the hallmarks of this devotion and all its exercises. It is important for us to know that **Consecration** and **Reparation** are very central to the devotion to the Sacred Heart.

By Consecration we mean, a formal way to dedicate

ourselves to the Sacred Heart by acknowledging Him as our creator and redeemer and as having full rights over us as King of Kings, by repenting and resolving to serve Him.

Reparation: We make amends and atone for the indifference and ingratitude with which He is treated and for leaving Him abandoned by humanity in spite of His great love.

Conclusively, let us know that the Heart of Jesus longs for us to offer our gratitude, love, and devotion in return. The Sacred Heart emphasizes love and mercy. The Sacred Heart beckons us to enter into the divine furnace of Love. In the Sacred Heart we see the love of God which created the heavens and the earth; a love which created humankind and then redeemed us in our fallen nature.

A true devotion to the Sacred Heart is important because it is a true devotion to the Heart of God Himself, since the very core of Christianity is expressed in the Heart of Jesus.

Cucumbers and salads are synonymous with each other. It is often considered as a fruit as well as a vegetable by experts as it belongs to the same plant family as that of the pumpkin, squash and watermelon, i.e. the Cucurbitaceae family.

Cucumber Nutritional Facts

Cucumbers contain 96% per cent of water. They are ideal for detoxification and preventing dehydration. Cucumbers are rich in phytonutrients and vitamin K. They are also a very good source of pantothenic acid and Molybdenum. They also contain copper, potassium, manganese, vitamin C, phosphorus, magnesium and vitamin B I.

10 HEALTH BENEFITS OF CUCUMBERS:

I. Good for Hydration & Detoxification:

Cucumbers are 96% water. Consuming cucumbers, adds to the daily requirement of water by the body, thus keeping us hydrated. This is helpful, especially during summers when we tend to get dehydrated easily. Cucumber also acts as a coolant, providing us relief from the summer heat.

Detox water made using cucumber and mint, effectively eliminates toxins from the body, improves hydration and thus results in innumerable health benefits.

2. Regulates Blood Pressure:

Cucumbers are a good source of potassium, magnesium and dietary fibre. These nutrients are known to lower blood pressure, thus reducing the risk of heart diseases.

Research has also proved that regular consumption of cucumber juice was helpful in reducing blood pressure, in elderly people with hypertension.

3. Good for Digestion:

Cucumbers act as a coolant for our stomach. The soluble fibre in cucumbers helps in slowing our digestion.

Also, the high content of water in cucumber makes our stools soft, prevents constipation and keeps our bowel movements regular.

4. Reduces Blood Sugar:

Cucumbers are known to reduce blood sugar levels, thus being helpful in the management and prevention of diabetes mellitus.

5. Helpful in Weight Loss:

Cucumbers contain 96% of water and are low in calories. There are only 15.5 calories in 100 g of cucumber. The high water and low-calorie content of cucumbers help in reducing weight.

6. Better Skin:

Cucumbers are great beauty enhancers. They show amazing effects on the skin. The application of cucumber juice on the skin makes it soft and glowy. Anti inflammatory effects of cucumber naturally lighten our skin and reduce tanning. It also reduces wrinkles and fine lines.

7. Soothes our Eyes:

Keeping cucumber slices on the eyes for about 10 minutes relaxes our eyes and reduces puffiness around the eyes.

8. Reduces the Risk of Cancer:

The fibre in cucumbers protects from colorectal cancer. Also, cucurbitacin present in cucumbers possesses anti cancer properties.

9. Good for Hair and Nails:

Cucumbers contain silica which is excellent for hair and nail care. They help in strengthening the nails and prevent them from becoming brittle.

10. Prevents Bad Breath:

Phytochemicals present in cucumber destroy the bacteria in our mouth that cause bad breath.

How to consume cucumbers?

It is best to eat cucumbers unpeeled, to prevent loss of some fibre, vitamins and minerals.

§ Raw cucumbers can be tossed in salads, sandwiches and curd for a crunchy taste.

§ You can make sabzi and soups out of them.

How to store cucumbers?

Wrap cucumbers in plastic wrap and store them in the refrigerator, so that they remain fresh and last longer.

COMPONENTS OF MERCY.

Whenever we reflect about our present pope (Pope Francis) what comes to our minds? Hopefully we are reflecting about mercy, compassion, and forgiveness. These are some characteristics of his papacy and in fact, this was the reason he declared a jubilee year of mercy on December 8th 2015. We can apply Pope Francis's vision of mercy in our daily lives by starting with the spiritual/ corporal works of mercy, something more fundamental is needed. The Holy Father defines mercy as revealing the mystery of the most Holy Trinity, the supreme act by which God comes to meet us in the incarnation of Christ. In order for us to fully enter into the works of mercy, we must first enter into the Joy and Peace that comes from experiencing and sharing in God's mercy.

Here God show us one of the components of mercy, (i.e.) compassion.

What is compassion: it is when I let my heart reach out to feel another's pain and joy. It is not sympathy from a distance; it's being with and for another person on a personal and emotional level. These require us to put ourselves in the other person's shoes and hurt with them. In a sense, the incarnation was the ultimate act of compassion of God. St Paul clearly invites us to compassion when he says "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as Christ God forgave you"—Ephesians 4:32

In Jesus Christ and through Jesus Christ, God also becomes especially visible in his mercy ... above all, he himself makes mercy incarnate and personifies it. Jesus Christ not only demonstrates compassion to us by taking on our humanity and even our suffering in his own passion, he commands it from us when he gives us the golden rule in the sermon on the mount to "do unto others whatever you would want done to you" (Jn. 7:12). Also his admonition of "let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her (John 8:7) is also a plea for compassion from us, so Christ calls us to have compassion on others just as he had on us whenever we ourselves fall short. Whenever we insist on justice for our hurts instead of using compassion, hurts can grow deeper instead of being healed. Mercy becomes an indispensable element for shaping mutual relationship between people in a spirit of deepest respect for what is human and in a spirit of mutual sisterhood. It is impossible to establish this bond between people if they wish to regulate their mutual relationships solely according to the measure of justice.

On the 22nd of June 2022, during the festival of families, the Holy Fatheraddressed families and made them understand that each family has a mission to carry out in the world, a testimony to give. He said to them "Be the seed of a more fraternal world! Be families with big hearts! Be the welcoming face of the Church! And please pray, always pray!" need to feel welcomed and accepted, for all those who need to encounter Christ and to know that they are loved. The Holy Father invites family to announce the beauty of being family with joy.

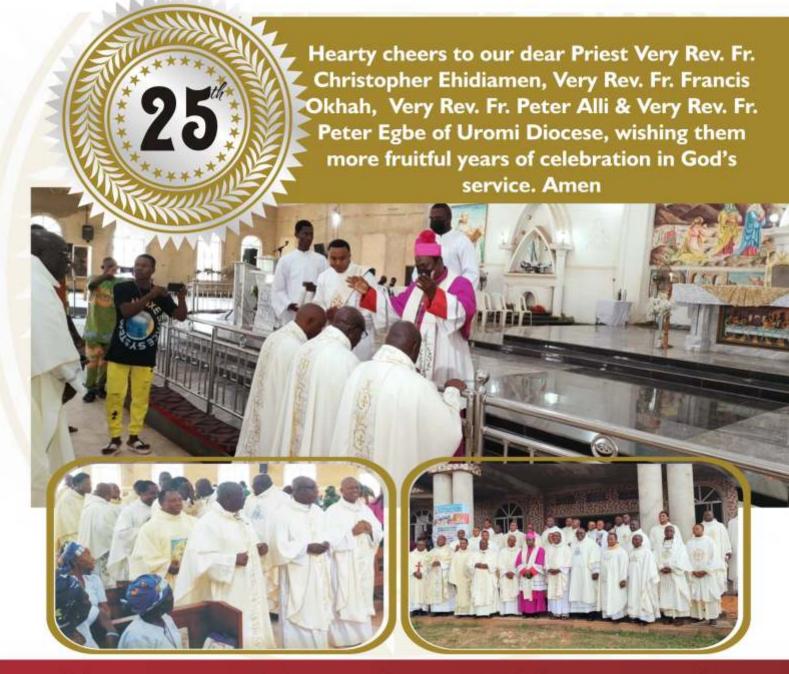

HOW TO GET TO THE RETREAT CENTRE

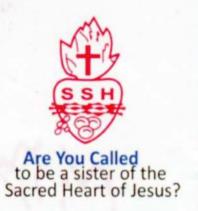
- By car from South East Drive to Isele Uku and take Onicha
