PREFACE

This revised prayer manual is a compilation of prayers in use by the Adoration Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus at different times of the day and season, and for different intentions. It lays down precise guidelines for prayer at different times in our different Communities. When we adhere to this, we form a discipline that is beyond what each person will feel like doing, as this is not a leisure practice but a path to be in closer union with God.

The Prayer manual includes prayers, meant not only to impact our personal lives as Sisters, but also the Society and the World at large. It was basically rearranged to follow the order of the day. This will help make praying easier for both Sisters and Visitors to the Convent that join the Sisters in prayers.

Prayer, as we know is an inner movement of the heart and mind towards God. Nevertheless, this movement of the heart can be expressed in many ways. As speech is necessary for human survival and thriving, our Community prayers together is also necessary for spiritual growth and holiness. Hence, it is fitting that the content of our hearts should be expressed outwardly in words. In this way, we pray with our whole being, body and spirit and we also are able to pray with others. In doing so, we follow the example of Jesus, who prayed vocally in the synagogue with

friends, family, and strangers, and in private by himself (CCC 2700 - 2704).

Therefore, as we use this prayer manual as a guide and spiritual tool to increase our daily prayer life, let us endeavor to focus on every word of the prayers. Bringing the meaning of the words into our hearts and not rushing through the prayers like we are in a hurry to get them over with. Let them slowly enter into the depths of our hearts with humility and awe of God.

Sweet Jesus, give your blessing to the ardent desire we now entertain and the holy resolution we have taken of ever loving and adoring you, with our whole mind and with our whole heart, in the sacrament of your love, thus to repair by true conversion of heart and an ardent zeal for your glory, our past negligence and infidelities. Be you, O Adorable Heart who knows the clay of which we are formed, our mediator with your Heavenly Father whom we have so grievously offended; strengthen our weakness, confirm our resolution and with your charity, humility, meekness and patience, blot out the multitude of our iniquities. Be our support, our refuge and our strength, that nothing henceforth, in life or death, may separate us from you. Amen.

in our minds by the purity, simplicity and firmness of our faith and in our hearts by love for you alone, that love of you above all things which the Holy Spirit inspires and the flames of which we resolve by your grace to keep ever burning brightly by the frequent worthy reception of the sacraments of your loving mercy and forgiveness and of your body and blood in the Holy Eucharist.

Reflection: The gift of wisdom corresponds to the virtue of charity. In the gift of wisdom, we see God at work in our lives and in the world. For the wise person, the wonders of nature, historical events, and the ups and downs of our lives take on deeper meaning. The matters of judgment about the truth, and being able to see the whole image of God. We see God as our Father and other people with dignity. Lastly being able to see God in everyone and everything everywhere.

Concluding Prayer

(All): O Lord, grant that we may despise the perishable things of this world, and aspire only after the things that are eternal and to love them more above all things. Amen

Day 3.....Col 4:5-6

Reflection: The gift of understanding

corresponds to the virtue of faith. In understanding, we comprehend how we need to live as a follower of Christ. A person with understanding is not confused by all the conflicting messages in our culture about the right way to live our Christian life. This gift perfects a person's untested reason in the understanding of truth, where self-evident principles are known

Concluding Prayer

(All): O Holy Spirit enlighten our minds with the light of your divine truth, that we may know and believe all the mysteries of salvation; and may at last merit the eternal light in your glory, and have a clear vision of you and the Father and the Son. Amen.

Day 4..... Prov. 12:15

Reflection: The gift of Counsel (right judgment) corresponds to the virtue of prudence. With the gift of counsel/right judgment, we know the difference between right and wrong, and we choose to do what

is right. A person with right judgment avoids sin and lives out the values taught by Jesus. This gift of truth that allows the person to respond prudently, and happily to believe Christ the Lord.

Concluding Prayer

(All): O Spirit of Counsel, grant that we may ever choose the surest ways of pleasing God and gaining heaven; Incline our hearts to what is good; turn it away from all that is evil, and direct us by the straight path of your commandments. Amen.

Day 5..... 2Tim. 1:6-8

Reflection: The gift of Fortitude corresponds to the virtue of courage. With the gift of fortitude, we overcome our fear and are willing to take risks as followers of Jesus Christ. A person with courage is willing to stand up for what is right in the sight of God, even if it means accepting rejection, verbal abuse, or even physical

harm and death. The gift of courage allows people the firmness of mind that is required both in doing good and in enduring evil, especially with regards to good or evil that are difficult.

Concluding Prayer

(All): O Blessed Spirit of Fortitude, strengthen our weaknesses, that we may bear our crosses with you, and overcome with courage all the obstacles that oppose our salvation. May we never be overcome and separated from you, who are our God and greatest good. Amen

Day 6..... Prov. 18:13-15

Reflection: The gift of Knowledge corresponds to the virtue of hope. With the gift of knowledge, we understand who God is. It is more than an accumulation of facts. It is the ability to study, learn and judge correctly matters of faith and right actions, and to put what is learned to good use for constructive purposes.

Concluding Prayer

(All): Come, O Blessed Spirit of Knowledge, and grant that we may perceive the will of the Father; show us the nothingness of earthly things, that we may realize their vanity and use them only for your glory and our own salvation, looking ever beyond them to you and your eternal rewards. Amen.

Day 7..... 1Tim 4:7-8

Reflection: The gift of Piety, sometimes called reverence, corresponds to the virtue of justice, which at the Holy Spirit's instigation, we pay worship and duty to God as our Father.

With this gift, we have a deep sense of respect for God and the church. A person with reverence recognizes total reliance on God and comes before God with humility, trust, and love.

Concluding Prayer

(All): Come, O Blessed Spirit of Piety, possess our hearts. Enkindle in us such love for God that we may find the service of God

sweet and amiable and, for His sake, lovingly submit to all legitimate authority. Amen.

Day 8..... Philip. 2:12-15

Reflection: The gift of the Fear of God corresponds to the virtue of temperance. The Holy fear of God is, in this context, “filial” or chaste fear whereby we revere God and avoid separating ourselves from him—as opposed to “servile” fear, whereby we fear punishment. In this gift, we acknowledge that everything comes as a gift from God, thereby downplaying our personal achievements and self-sufficiency, and in return gladly offer praise, worship and adoration to God.

Concluding Prayer

(All): Come, O blessed Spirit of Holy Fear, penetrate our inmost heart, that we may set you, our Lord and God, before our faces forever; help us to shun all things that can offend you, and make us worthy to appear before the pure eyes of your Divine

Majesty in heaven where you live and reign in the unity of the Blessed Trinity, God, world without end. Amen.

Day 9..... Gal. 5:16-25

Reflection: The gifts of the Holy Spirit perfect the supernatural virtues by enabling us to practice them with greater docility to divine inspiration. As we grow in the knowledge and love of God under the direction of the Holy Spirit, our service becomes more sincere and generous, the practice of virtue, more perfect. Such acts of virtue leave the heart filled with joy and consolation and are known as Fruits of the Holy Spirit. These Fruits in turn render the practice of virtue more attractive, and become a powerful incentive for still greater effort in the service of God.

Concluding Prayer

(All): Come, O Divine Spirit, fill our hearts with your heavenly fruits: charity, joy, peace, patience, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith, mildness, modesty, self-

Hence the wound of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus, now that He has completed His mortal life, remains through the course of the ages a striking image of that

spontaneous charity by which God gave His only begotten Son for the redemption of men and by which Christ expressed such passionate love for us that He offered Himself as a bleeding victim on Calvary for our sake: "Christ loved us and delivered Himself for us, an oblation and a sacrifice to God for an odor of sweetness. **Haurietis Aquas #78.**

Introduction: (Christ' gift of Himself). To the unbloody gift of Himself under the appearance of bread and wine our Savior Jesus Christ wished to join, as the chief proof of His deep and infinite love, the bloody sacrifice of the Cross. By this manner of acting He gave an example of His supreme charity, which He had proposed to His disciples as the highest point of love in these words: "Greater love than this no man hath, that a man lay down his life for his friends. **Haurietis Aquas #73.**

Introduction: (Behold your Mother)
Another most precious gift of His Sacred Heart is, as we have said, Mary the beloved Mother of God and the most loving Mother of us all. She who gave birth to our Savior according to the flesh and was associated with Him in recalling the children of Eve to the life of divine grace has deservedly been hailed as the spiritual Mother of the whole human race. And so St. Augustine writes of her: "Clearly She is Mother of the members of the Savior (which is what we are), because She labored with Him in love that the faithful who are members of the Head might be born in the Church. **Haurietis Aquas #72.**

Day 8:

Introduction: (Love inspires us to spread the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus).
We therefore urge all Our children in

Christ, both those who are already accustomed to drink the saving waters flowing from the Heart of the Redeemer and, more especially those who look on from a distance like hesitant spectators, to eagerly embrace this devotion. Let them carefully consider, as we have said, that it is a question of a devotion which has long been powerful in the Church and is solidly founded on the Gospel narrative. It received clear support from tradition and the Sacred Liturgy and has been frequently and generously praised by the Roman Pontiffs themselves. These were not satisfied with establishing a feast in honor of the most Sacred Heart of the Redeemer and extending it to the Universal Church; they were also responsible for the solemn acts of dedication which consecrated the whole human race to the same Sacred Heart.

APPENDIX I CREATIVE WAYS FOR MARIAN DEVOTION

MODE 1

The community sits in a circle with a lighted candle held by the leader, while the scriptural reading on the Mystery is taken by different Sisters while passing the symbol i.e lighted candle. The “Hail Mary” is prayed.

MODE 2

Meditation on the Mysteries guided by Scriptural reading.

MODE 3

All kneel, a hymn to Mary is sung and the Litany is recited.

MODE 4

The Rosary is prayed privately.

MODE 5

As normal with procession.

MODE 6

As normal without procession.

MODE 7

A tape can be used to lead the Rosary while the Sisters pray along.

APPENDIX II CREATIVE WAYS OF PRAYING THE LAUDS AND VESPERS

Lauds as morning prayers and vespers as evening prayers are the two hinges of the Divine Office. They are the chief hours and are to be celebrated as such (Vatican II, Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy Sacrosanctum Concilium 89A no. 100).

Note: The Liturgist should be creative in leading the Sisters in praying the Psalms. She should moderate whichever mode she chooses.

Mode 1

Two groups alternate the Psalm, and a Sister, alone, takes the intercessory prayers.

Mode 2

Instrumental introit with silent meditation

before the Psalms.

Mode 3

The Psalms are prayed silently alongside music in background.

Mode 4

Prayer as normal.

Mode 5

The Cantor(s) alternates the Psalm with the Sisters.

Mode 6

Everybody rises up for the Glory be to the father; then joining of our hands together in solidarity as we say the Lord's prayer.

Mode 7

Gestures, actions, symbols, signs are practiced in the hour e.g burning of incense raising of hands, dancing and bowing etc.

Mode 8

Pray the Psalms silently and read aloud a striking phrase from it

**APPENDIX III
FAITH SHARING
PREAMBLE**

Faith sharing is an exercise rooted in the Gospel. And it demands TRUST. It is a sharing that involves telling our sacred stories. It also involves sharing our experience of faith. It is not a time for admonition or sermon or moralizing (this is not exhortation, preaching or moralizing. All comments must be “I, My, Me, not “You”, They”, “We”, or using verbs like “should”). It is an exercise in which each individual Jesus' faces question “who do you say I am?”. ”In faith sharing we tap from the gift of faith of others.

**METHOD 1
STEP 1**

Introduction by the Liturgist

STEP 2

The invocation of the Holy Spirit

STEP 3

Leader reads a scriptural text. **(Pause for 2 minutes)**

STEP 4

The leader repeats the scripture passage

STEP 5

Reflection on the passage for 10 minutes
(what is God's personal message)

STEP 6

Sharing of one's reflection with the group.

STEP 7

What did I hear others share? What message does God have for me in what others have shared?

STEP 8

Prayer of gratitude and thankfulness.

METHOD 2

STEP 1

Introduction by the Liturgist

STEP 2

Invocation of the Holy Spirit

STEP 3

We read a text

STEP 4

We pick out words and meditate on them

STEP 5

We let God speak to us in silence

STEP 6

We share what we have heard in our hearts (i.e. which word has touched me personally? We may share also on any spiritual experience. We don't discuss or comment on others contribution. We may also share by singing, praying or commenting on the text read.)

STEP 7

We pray together spontaneously.

METHOD 3

STEP 1

Introduction by the Liturgist

STEP 2

Invocation of the Holy Spirit

STEP 3

Read a Scriptural/Spiritual passage

STEP 4

Observe Silence

STEP 5

Sing appropriate hymn or song

STEP 6

Share on each Sister's giftedness

STEP 7

Hold the hands of the Sister next to you and pray for her

STEP 8

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Conclude with the Lord's Prayer

METHOD 4

(Symbols may be used here)

STEP 1

Introduction by the Liturgist

STEP 2

Opening prayer

STEP 3

Sing praises to God

STEP 4

Scriptural reading or any inspiring passage

STEP 5

Share either from the passage/ the day's encounter or experience or on the symbols presented

STEP 6

Song of thanksgiving

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STEP 7

Conclude as wish.
